Nominations must be submitted by May 30th of each year and awards will be made by second Sunday of August annually.

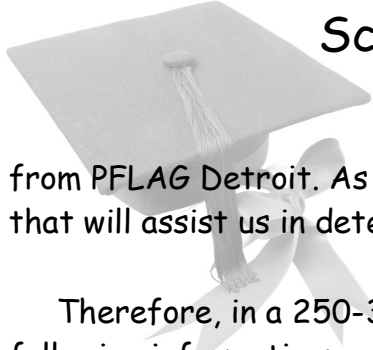

Also consider including some information from the following questions:

What colleges you have applied to?

How would you describe yourself?

How would your teachers describe you?

What personal accomplishments make you the most proud?

Why do you want to go to college?

What two or three extracurricular activities have you participated in? And why do you participate?

What person has been influential in your life? Why?

Why would you be an excellent recipient of the PFLAG scholarship?

Letters of recommendation are accepted as well.
